


**Updates on Hawai'i's two most active volcanoes,  
Kīlauea and Mauna Loa**

Kīlauea has erupted nearly continuously since 1983, when a vent, now called Pu'u 'Ō'ō, opened on the volcano's East Rift Zone. In 2008, a second vent opened within Halema'uma'u Crater at the summit of Kīlauea. Both eruptions are ongoing. Mauna Loa erupted most recently in 1984 and is expected to erupt again. USGS Hawaiian Volcano Observatory volcanologist **Mike Poland** talks about the current status of Mauna Loa, updates us on Kīlauea's summit eruption, and presents a brief overview of the East Rift Zone eruption's first 30 years, followed by an in-depth account of the Pu'u 'Ō'ō lava flow that has advanced toward Pāhoā over the past six months.
